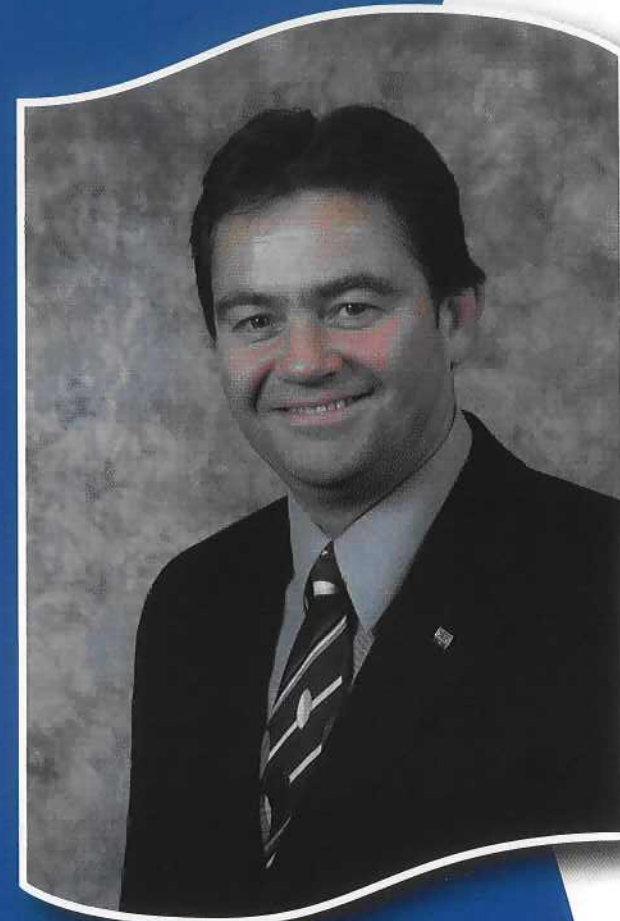

I have also been very active in a number of other organizations, which has helped in building my leadership and communication skills, and in keeping me informed about the current trends in our industry.

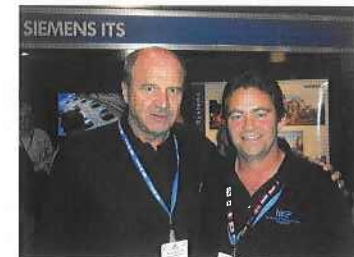
